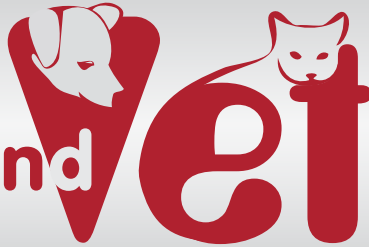

Comfortis – new monthly flea treatment
